TIME OF CLASS AND GOING HOME TIME:

9.00am - 1.30pm School starts at 9.00am.

No children will be allowed into the classrooms before this time as staff will be doing preparation for the school day. There is room to wait in the Hall or Parents Room. Please make sure that your child is in school before 9.15am. The front door will be locked after this time for security reasons and reopened at 1.20pm. Entrance between these times may be gained by using the buzzer.

Going home time is between 1.20pm and 1.30pm

*Please make sure you keep to these times as children can become very upset if their parents/carers are late.

SNACKS/DINNERS 

Please have snack/dinner money in the small bag provided with the child's name marked on it. Snack/dinner money should be paid on a Monday morning.

Snack £3.00 per week

Dinners £2.50 per day = £12.50 per week

Total £15.50 per week

Just to remind parents that those who are on working tax credit can claim for free dinners.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Jumpers and coats need to be clearly marked with your child's name.
- Children should be wearing trainers or shoes with Velcro fastenings - no laces please.

- Jewellery/earrings are not allowed as they can be dangerous for the children. Small stud earrings will be allowed.
- We would appreciate if you could send in one box of tissues per term.
- Parents do not need to send anything into the Nursery School if it is their child's birthday. We will supply a cake and take photographs etc.
- Please remember that, at this time of year, Head Lice can be very prevalent. Try to check your child's head at least once a week. If you should find any head lice then please inform the school immediately.

TOPICS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR

We encourage the children to contribute towards displays throughout the school year. A monthly plan will also be placed in the hall to inform parents of the topics their children will be covering.

ECO NEWS

CAR PARKING

SAFETY OF CHILDREN

Parents should ensure that their child takes your hand coming into and leaving the school. No child should be allowed to run ahead of parents out through the school gates.

SECURITY OF CHILDREN

The school must always be informed in the morning if someone different is picking up the child. Adults should always come inside to the classroom door. No one under the age of 16 years will be allowed to collect children.
